Oriental Breeze

Don Julio Blanco, kiwi fruit, lime leaves, Midori, fresh lime juice, ginger beer.

KIWI FRUIT: Holds a mild level of lutein, also known as a phytochemical. High content of vitamin C, beneficial towards the gums and their rejuvenation, and healing for wounds.

Chinese Lantern

Fresh mandarin, Aperol, St. Germain, passion fruit syrup, plum bitters, champagne.

MANDARIN: used in the treatment of indigestion, allergies, digestive disorders and mastitis. In addition to its healing powers, hiccups and coughing are ailments that can benefit from mandarin. It is also known to enhance blood circulation and as an aphrodisiac.

Comfortably Numb

Stolichnaya vanilla, fresh chilli, Szechuan pepper honey, lychee liqueur, fresh lime juice.

SZECHUAN PEPPER (Chuan jiao): Warms, disperses cold, alleviates spleen or stomach cold from deficiency patterns.

Taoist blossom

Pu-Erh tea tincture, Monkey Shoulder, Branca Menta, Umeshu plum wine, chocolate bitters, peach liqueur, Antica Formula.

PU-ERH TEA: Eases flu; reduces cholesterol; lowers glucose levels in the blood stream; reduces hypertension. Antiseptic properties; promotes clean and clear liver fats. Its antioxidants activate the brains cells.

Belvedere bison grass vodka, galangal, coriander, apple juice, fresh lemon juice, pear, elderflower cordial.

CHINESE PARSLEY (Coriander): Chinese herbal medicine uses coriander or Chinese parsley for measles, stomach ache, poor appetite and dyspepsia, and as a tonic and aphrodisiac. Thought to improve circulation of qi-energy in the stomach, it has also been used to treat various types of pain. During the Han dynasty, coriander was thought to have the power to make people immortal.

GALANGAL: Stimulant and carminative. It is especially recommended as a remedy for sea-sickness. It tones up the tissues and is sometimes prescribed in fever. Homoeopaths use it as a stimulant. Galangal is used in cattle medicine, and the Arabs use it to make their horses fiery.

Hutong Crusta

Hennessy Fine de Cognac, fresh kumquat, Maraschino, star anise tincture, Grand Marnier, tamarind syrup, lemon juice.

STAR ANISE: Ancient Chinese physicians used the herb as a digestive aid and breath freshener. Early English herbalists recommended the herb for hiccups, for promoting milk production for nursing mothers, for headache, asthma, bronchitis, insomnia, infant colic and cholera.

Dragon Pearl

Tanqueray 10, ginger & lemongrass cordial, agave nectar, fresh dragon fruit, anise basil.

DRAGON FRUIT: boosts immune system; lowers blood glucose levels in type 2 diabetes; cleans toxins. Rich in flavonoids that are known to have favourable effects against cardio-related disease.

Buffalo Trace, five-spice bitters, Cocchi Rouge, Ratafia, blood orange juice.

FIVE-SPICE POWDER: Prevents and treats indigestion; lowers cholesterol and strengthens the immune system, relieves coughs and bronchitis. Effective against tooth-ache and joint pain; boosts cognitive function and memory.
